Analytics features added to JusticeXchange®
New features to broaden scope of criminal investigations

Louisville, Ky. –Law enforcement professionals who use JusticeXchange® now have new tools to help them fight crime in their jurisdictions.

JusticeXchange is an integrated justice solution that provides instant, up-to-date access to booking records, incident reports, and other data from thousands of agencies across the country. The ability to map incident reports and view relationships is now available to help users analyze the data being presented.

Link analysis is a key feature recently added to the service. A Person Search will retrieve data including relationships, such as other individuals who have used the same address, phone number, and more. This information is often critical in identifying criminal associates.

With the addition of analytics, a user can perform a Location Search by entering an address and radius to view specific crimes in selected time periods on a map. Users also can drill down by type of crime and view charts of the crimes by area and time. This helps law enforcement evaluate which areas need the most personnel to help combat the crime.

“The additions of link analysis and a mapping tool are key to providing criminal justice agencies with the most up-to-date technology to help serve and protect the community,” said Theresa DaSilva, senior product manager. “More analytic features will be continually added to JusticeXchange for use by the law enforcement community.”
