Appriss, provider of VINE® — the National Victim Notification Network and other technology solutions that help government agencies serve and protect their citizens, provides an instant, up-to-date database of booking records, incident reports, and other data from hundreds of agencies across the country.

Appriss was formed in 1994 to provide automated victim notification. Today, the organization provides victim notification services in 41 states, including 20 of the nation's largest metropolitan areas.

Through the Operations Centers in Louisville, Kentucky, Appriss provides real-time information detailing every person held in custody in nearly 70 percent of the nation's jails and state departments of corrections. This information allows local law enforcement to notify victims when offenders are released, as well as track offenders and investigate crimes. In addition, Appriss provides on-demand, real-time access to pharmacy logs that gives law enforcement the ability to monitor suspicious buying patterns for illegal methamphetamine production.

Nlets is the pre-eminent interstate law enforcement network in the nation for the exchange of law enforcement and related justice information. Nlets, which is owned by the states, is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, which was created by principal law enforcement agencies of the states nearly 40 years ago. The user population is composed of all of the states/territories, every Federal agency with a justice component, and selected international agencies, all cooperatively exchanging data. The types of data being exchanged vary from motor vehicle and drivers' data, Canadian "Hot File" records, and Immigration and Naturalization Service ("INS") databases to state criminal history records. More than 70 million messages are transacted each month.

The mission of Nlets is to provide, within a secure environment, an international justice telecommunications capability and information services that will benefit to the highest degree, the safety, the security, and the preservation of human life and the protection of property. Nlets assists those national and international governmental agencies and other organizations with similar missions that enforce or aid in enforcing local, state, or international laws or ordinances.
