North Las Vegas, Nevada – Crime victims throughout the City of North Las Vegas now have 24-hour access to custody information about offenders held in the North Las Vegas Detention Center.

Citizens can contact the North Las Vegas Victim Notification Service at 1-888-NLV-VINE (1-888-658-8463). To track the custody status of an offender, go to the City of North Las Vegas Police Department (<http://www.cityofnorthlasvegas.com/Departments/Police/Police.shtm>) and click on the VINE button in the sidebar. This information is updated every seven minutes to ensure that notifications can be made in a timely manner.

Live operators are available around the clock, seven days a week to assist victims who need help obtaining offender information or registering for notification. The service is free and anonymous.

The notification system is intended to help victims, however, the system can be used by family members, attorneys, law enforcement agencies or media personnel. This service is provided by the North Las Vegas Police and Detention Center in partnership with Appriss, Inc. – a Louisville, Kentucky-based technology company that provides innovative resources to thousands of local, state and federal government agencies – to keep our citizens informed.
