

Latest Web Enhancements

The second JusticeXchange Web release of 2007 is coming and contains many new, exciting features. The following enhancements are included in the June 27th release:

- Regional searching will be available (Figure 1). One or multiple regions can be selected to help narrow the Locations options of your Search page(s).
- User Roles are changing (Figure 2). Instead of only classifying yourself as Civilian or Sworn Law Enforcement, subcategories of groups such as Drug Task Force, Probation/Parole, and many others will be used to allow access to certain data types. Contact your Agency Administrator to ensure you are assigned the proper User Role.
- You will now receive a reminder e-mail a week before your password expires.
- The Logic Search functionality on the Name Search has improved. Physical characteristics will now be taken into account on the result's scoring. For example, a search for Jim Brown with brown hair will return that individual with a higher score than a Jim Brown with black hair.
- Administrators can now export the User/Agency Search and Usage Reports into an excel or pdf format for future reference.

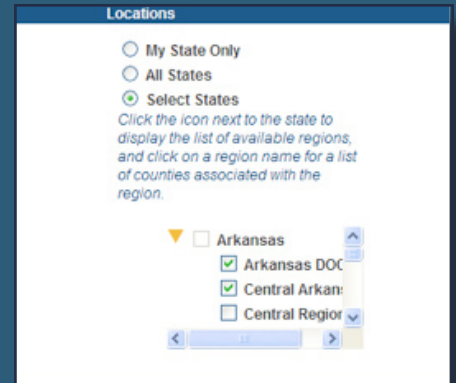

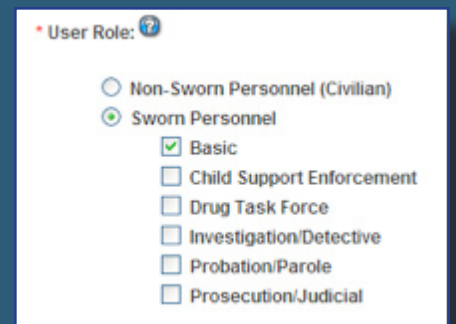

Child Support Enforcement Locates Dead-Beat Parents with the help of JusticeXchange

Jacob J. van der Oort, Supervisor of the State Parent Locate Section of the Kentucky Division of Child Support, uses JusticeXchange to help track down parents who owe child support. If he finds that a parent he is looking for has a suspended license or no recent wages, there is a good possibility the individual may be in jail somewhere. In January alone, van der Oort was able to locate 121 parents because of JusticeXchange.



I believe JusticeXchange is an extremely valuable tool to child support agencies. The application allows child support staff to obtain correctional data, residential addresses and employers quickly and efficiently without a single phone call.
